Revision doesn't have to be dull or painful! Mix things up a bit and make it fun. It's worth it because when you put the work in you get results!

If you're unsure, this is what we mean!

BINGO!	EXPLANATION
3 IN A ROW	Complete 3 different types of revision activity in a day (e.g. flash cards, mind mapping and a past paper).
ADAPT A PLAN	Make a change to your timetable based on what's gone well - or not so well - from a previous week's plan.
ALL THE CONFIDENCE	Go through a subject breakdown and mark your confidence level for each subtopic - High, Medium or Low.
CHECK-IN CHAT	Have a conversation about how revision is going with a parent, carer or tutor.
EARLY BIRD REVISER	Complete a revision session before 11:00 AM.
EFFORT CHECK	Talk about a day's revision activity to someone, explaining why each task was useful.
FLASHCARDFUL	Create a set of 50 new flashcards for a core subject in a day.
FORWARD PLANNER	Make a SMART goal for January or the Spring Term. (<i>SMART means: Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-constrained.</i>)
PASSED PAST PAPER	Take one essay style, big mark question and plan out the answer in bullet points. Then review it against the mark scheme.
QUIZ MASTER	Write 10 multiple choice questions on one subject for your family to answer over dinner.
QUOTE BLURT	Scribble down as many quotes as you can remember from one of your texts. Then check!
REVIEW ONLY	Spend 20 minutes reviewing marked tests or homework, looking only at the errors.
SPACED-OUT	Build a timetable of revision topics for the week, without having the same subject twice in a row.
STUDY SPRINT	Complete a focused 30-minute revision session (with a timer that isn't your phone!).
THOSE WHO CAN	Take a difficult topic and explain it to a parent or sibling so they understand it.
WATER LOT TO DRINK	Drink 4 full glasses of water while revising today.
